This internal reprogramming action transfers \$6 million from the Other Procurement, Navy, 02/04, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 02/03, appropriation. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 107-117, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2002, and section 1001 of Public Law 107-107, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2002. Reclassification is required to properly execute funds in accordance with congressional intent. This realignment does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated, meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and has not previously been denied by the Congress.



Explanation: The Congress added \$6.0 million in FY 2002 for the development of the Digital Modular Radio (DMR) to be compliant with the Joint Tactical Radio System (JTRS) hardware and software architecture to allow the fielding of an initial set of JTRS-compliant waveforms that satisfy the JTRS Maritime requirements. This funding will support accelerating the migration of DMR to JTRS compliance allowing the Navy to take advantage of the waveforms being developed under JTRS Joint Program Office funding. This migration effort is appropriately funded in the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy appropriation. Therefore, a reclassification reprogramming is necessary to execute these funds in the proper account.
