

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Explanation: The Congress provided \$1.4 million in the FY 2002 DoD Appropriations Act for the Composite Track Improvement Program. Composite Track is a metal compound program that requires further research to determine optimum utility for the Army. The increase was erroneously placed in the Abrams Tank line. This action realigns the funds (adjusted for undistributed reductions) to the Metal Matrix Composites line for proper execution.
