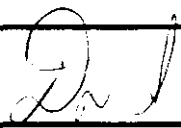

This internal reprogramming action transfers the FY 2002 Supplemental funds from the Defense Emergency Response Fund (DERF) to various appropriations to meet the most urgent requirements for the Global War on Terrorism. The transfer authority is contained in the 2002 Supplemental Appropriations Act for Further Recovery from and Response to Terrorist Attacks on the United States, Public Law 107-206, Chapter 3. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and has not been previously denied by the Congress.
