This prior approval reprogramming action transfers \$360.818 million from the Shipbuilding and Conversion, Navy, 02/06, appropriation to the National Defense Sealift Fund for the T-AKE dry cargo ship. This transfer does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This action uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 107-117, the DoD Appropriations Act, FY 2002, and section 1001 of Public Law 107-107, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2002. This reprogramming meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and has not been denied by the Congress.

In FY 2002, Congress appropriated funds in the Shipbuilding and Conversion, Navy appropriation for the ADC(X) class of ships (subsequently redesignated as the T-AKE class of ships). However, the Congress has indicated a preference that the National Defense Sealift Fund be used as the funding mechanism for combat logistics force (CLF) ships. This reprogramming action therefore transfers the T-AKE funds to the National Defense Sealift Fund. The reprogramming action does not alter the congressional intent for use of these funds. The funding balance represents undistributed reductions, associated with Public Law 107-117, section 8123 (anticipated savings and efficiencies).
