This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it initiates procurement of the Electronic Digital Compass System and Titanium Tilting Helmet Mounts. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law (P.L.) 107-117, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2002; and section 1001 of P.L. 107-107, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2002. 

In FY 2002, the Congress added \$1.4 million to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation (RDT&E), Defense-Wide appropriation for the Electronic Digital Compass System for the U.S. Special Operations Command (USSOCOM). However, the system is developed and requires only limited integration efforts with the Sniper Detection System. This action therefore realigns a portion of the funds (\$.875 million) from USSOCOM's RDT&E appropriation to its Procurement appropriation so procurement may be initiated.

The Congress also added \$1.0 million in FY 2002 for Titanium Tilting Helmet Mounts in RDT&E. This item has been developed and will be a Commercial-Off-the Shelf (COTS) procurement item. This action therefore transfers the funds from USSOCOM's RDT&E appropriation to its Procurement appropriation for proper execution.
