This internal reprogramming transfers \$8.9 million from the Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 02/04, appropriation to the Missile Procurement, Air Force, 02/04, appropriation for the Miniature Air-Launch Decoy program. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 107-117, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2002; and section 1001 of Public Law 107-107, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2002. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and the Congress has not denied any of the funds.

Explanation: Section 8050 of Public Law 107-248, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2003, rescinded \$114.6 million from the Missile Procurement, Air Force, 02/04, appropriation. Of this amount, \$8.9 million was to have been rescinded from the Miniature Air-Launch Decoy (MALD) program, as reflected on page 327 of the Statement of the Managers accompanying the FY 2003 DoD Appropriations Act. However, the MALD program resides in the War Consumables line item within the Aircraft Procurement appropriation. This action transfers funds from the program in the Aircraft Procurement appropriation to the Missile Procurement appropriation to accommodate the rescission.
