



This internal reprogramming action transfers funds from the Operations and Maintenance, Air Force, 03/03, appropriation to the Defense Health Program to properly execute funds for the International Military Education and Training (IMET) program. This action uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 107-248, the DoD program Appropriations Act, 2003; and section 1001 of Public Law 107-314, the Bob Stump National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2003. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the Congress has not denied any of the funds.

One of the Air Force programs identified for funding was the Institute for Global Health (IGH) led by the Air Force Surgeon General. The IGH program is a Defense Health Program funded program. This action, therefore, realigns the funds for proper execution.
