This internal reprogramming transfers \$9.5 million appropriated in Public Law 107-206 from the Other Procurement, Army, 02/04, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 02/03, appropriation for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 107-117, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2002, and section 1001 of Public Law 107-107, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2002. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated, it meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the Congress has not denied the item.

Explanation: In the 2002 Supplemental Appropriations Act for Further Recovery From and Response to Terrorist Attacks on the United States (P.L. 107-206), the Congress provided \$68.8 million in the Other Procurement, Army (OPA) appropriation and \$5.2 million in the Operation and Maintenance, Army (O&M,A) appropriation to support base operation requirements. In order to execute the required base support requirements, \$9.5 million of the OPA funds need to be transferred to the O&M,A appropriation for proper execution. Of these funds, \$7.3 million will support operations at Site-R and \$2.2 million will support upgrades at Ft. Belvoir, Virginia. This action will facilitate improvements and maintenance at both locations.
