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Explanation: The VMEP is a congressional special interest item. In the FY 2003 DoD Appropriations Act, the Congress provided \$4.2 million for VMEP, but the funds were erroneously appropriated to the UH-60 MODS line item. This action will realign the funds to the correct budget line for execution. The VMEP monitors the health and state of the helicopter main rotor system, engine, gear boxes, tail rotor and tail rotor drive system, and other components to include generators. The system provides diagnostic information to helicopter maintainers and maintenance managers in the operating units. The intent of the system is to keep vibrations at their lowest possible level, thereby minimizing collateral damage to weapons and avionics, consequently reducing operations and support costs.
