This internal reprogramming action performs three transfers of funds. In Part I, funds currently in the Defense Cooperation Account (DCA) are transferred to the Natural Resources Risk Remediation Fund (NRRRF). Part II, a portion of the FY 2003 Supplemental funds from the Iraqi Freedom Fund (IFF) are transferred to various appropriations to meet the most urgent requirements for Operation Iraqi Freedom and the Global War on Terrorism. Part III, funds from the NRRRF are transferred to Operation and Maintenance, Army, 03/03, appropriation for expenses incurred in and around Iraq for emergency fire fighting, to repair damaged oil facilities and related infrastructure, and to preserve a distribution capability. The authority is contained in Public Law 108-11, the FY 2003 Emergency Wartime Supplemental Appropriations Act. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress, and the Congress has not denied any of the items. This action affects Tactical Intelligence and Related Activities (TIARA) but does not affect Joint Military Intelligence Programs (JMIP) or the National Foreign Intelligence Program (NFIP).
