

SUBJECT: Housing Privatization Project – New Mexico

This memorandum implements the transfer of \$6.400 million from the Family Housing Construction, Air Force, 99/03, appropriation and \$17.900 million from the Family Housing Construction, Air Force, 02/06, appropriation to the DoD Family Housing Improvement Fund to finance a family housing privatization project at Kirkland Air Force Base, New Mexico.

Transfer authority is provided by section 123 of Public Law 107-249, the Military Construction Appropriations Act, 2003. A 45-day notification to the congressional committees is required prior to the transfer; March 10, 2002 is the last day of that notification period.

A data sheet that provides instructions for the transfer and apportionment of funds is attached. Immediate transfer and apportionment of funds on the 46th day is planned, unless one of the congressional committees objects. Therefore, the required apportionment documents and the SF 1151 (Non-Expenditure Transfer Authorization) should be ready for submittal to OMB and Treasury at the proper time.
