This reprogramming action transfers \$24.0 million from the Weapons Procurement, Navy, 03/05, appropriation back to the Iraq Freedom Fund, 03/04, appropriation. The transfer authority is contained in the Emergency Wartime Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2003, Public Law 108-11.

**Explanation:** The \$24.0 million was originally transferred from the Iraq Freedom Fund to finance additional tooling and test equipment for Tomahawk Cruise Missile production. A recent review of weapons use in the Iraq conflict has shown that the additional Tomahawk production capacity is not needed, so the previously transferred funding is available to transfer back into the Iraq Freedom Fund to finance other critical war requirements.
