This internal reprogramming action transfers \$301.4 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 04/05, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 04/04, appropriation (\$180.0 million) and the Other Procurement, Army, 04/06, appropriation (\$121.4 million). These funds will be used to procure items that are considered essential to improving the safety and security of U.S. forces in Iraq. This transfer authority is contained in the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense and for the Reconstruction of Iraq and Afghanistan, 2004, Public Law 108-106.

FY 2004 REPROGRAMMING INCREASES: **+301,400**

Operation and Maintenance, Army, 04/04 **+180,000**
Budget Activity 1: Operating Forces - - **+180,000**

Explanation: The funds will be used to finance the Commander’s Emergency Response Program (CERP) as directed in section 1110 of the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense and for the Reconstruction of Iraq and Afghanistan, Public Law 108-106. The Department is authorized to use up to \$180 million of funds made available in this Act to fund the CERP requirements.

Other Procurement, Army, 04/06 **+121,400**
Budget Activity 1: Tactical and Support Vehicles
Up-Armored High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicle - - **+110,500**

Explanation: These funds will be used to procure 534 Up-Armored High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicles (HMMWVs) for operations in Iraq. This procurement is necessary to enhance the survivability of soldiers and vehicles operating in the theater. Funding includes \$1.5 million for facilitization of production plan. This transfer includes \$62.1 million added by Congress in the FY 2004 Emergency Wartime Supplemental Appropriations Act specifically for procurement of these vehicles.

Budget Activity 2: Communications and Electronics **+10,900**
Night Vision, Thermal Weapon Sight - - **+10,900**

Explanation: The funds will be used to procure night vision devices; these devices will be issued with, and attached to, the 534 new Up-Armored HMMWVs for use in Iraq. The sights will enable effective night operations.
