This reprogramming action transfers \$57.5 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 03/04, appropriation to the Other Procurement, Army, 04/06, appropriation. These funds will be used to procure items that are considered essential to improving the safety and security of U.S. forces in Iraq. This transfer is pursuant to the Emergency Wartime Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2003, Public Law 108-11.

Explanation: The funds will be used to procure Warlock Orange electronic countermeasure systems. These are electronic protection systems that have been modified to counteract Improvised Explosive Devices. They are designed to protect personnel and high value assets by detonating incoming artillery and mortar proximity fuses outside of their lethal envelope. The Warlock Orange has enhanced capabilities to address the current evolving threats in Iraq.

Explanation: The funds will be used to procure 185 Raven Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs) for use in Iraq and Afghanistan. Combatant commands have a shortfall in reconnaissance and surveillance capabilities and require the Raven UAVs to provide real-time, detailed visual information on enemy strength, positions, and pending threats. The Raven is designed for the unit level (brigade and below). It is man portable and provides real-time data and surveillance.
