This internal reprogramming action transfers \$26.0 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 04/05, appropriation to Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 04/04, appropriation for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-87, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2004; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-136, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2004.
