Explanation: In accordance with Section 1901 of P.L. 108-11, \$2.0 million is transferred from Iraq Freedom Fund, appropriation to Military Construction, Defense-Wide, appropriation to construct critically important support facilities associated with the Combined/Joint Task Force (CJTF 180) Headquarters in Bagram, Afghanistan. The CJTF 180 HQ facility contract was awarded in September 2003, and an additional \$2.0 million is required to exercise the contract options to construct the support facilities.
