

This internal reprogramming action transfers \$7.1 million from Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 04/04, appropriation to the Research, Development, and Test, and Evaluation, Air Force, 04/05, appropriation for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005, Public Law 108-87, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2004; and section 1001 of the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2004. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and the Congress has not previously denied any of the items.

Explanation: The FY 2004 Operation and Maintenance, Air Force budget includes \$7.1 million for the Strategic War Planning System (SWPS), which is being modernized as part of the Nuclear Posture Review Implementation program to better support the warfighter and increase strategic war planning capabilities. Because it is a software development effort, this SWPS modernization effort should be funded with FY 2004 Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Air Force in lieu of FY 2004 Operation and Maintenance, Air Force funds. This reprogramming action transfers these funds into the correct appropriation for proper execution. It does not alter the congressional intent for use of these funds.
