This reprogramming action transfers \$298.9 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 04/05, appropriation to the Military Personnel, Marine Corps, 04/04, appropriation (\$157.0 million) and the Operation and Maintenance, Marine Corps, 04/04, appropriation (\$141.9 million). The funds will fund the deployment of a Marine Expeditionary Force for Operation Iraqi Freedom. The transfer authority is contained in the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense and for the Reconstruction of Iraq and Afghanistan, 2004, Public Law 108-106.

FY 2004 REPROGRAMMING INCREASES: **+298,900**

Military Personnel, Marine Corps, 04/04 **+157,000**

Budget Activity 1: Pay and Allowances of Officers **+84,700**

Budget Activity 2: Pay and Allowances of Enlisted Personnel **+63,400**

Budget Activity 4: Subsistence of Enlisted Personnel **+8,900**

Explanation: Funds are required to support the mobilization of Reserve personnel and the deployment of the second Marine Expeditionary Force in theater, including the associated Family Separation Allowance and Imminent Danger Pays.

Operation and Maintenance, Marine Corps, 04/04 **+141,900**

Budget Activity 1: Operating Forces **+141,900**

Explanation: Funds are required for the operational deployment and sustainment of 26,500 personnel in the second Marine Expeditionary Force.
