

This reprogramming action realigns \$.180 million from the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) and \$2.544 million from the Washington Headquarters Services (WHS) to the Defense Human Resources Activity (DHRA) (\$2.724 million) to reflect the transfer of the Department Advisory Committee on Women in the Services (DACOWITS) and Federal Voting Assistance Office (FVAO) functions from the OSD and WHS to the DHRA. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and the Congress has not denied any of the funds.
