This reprogramming action transfers \$7.6 million from Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 04/05, appropriation to Operation and Maintenance, Army, 04/04, appropriation (\$6.2 million) and Other Procurement, Army, 04/06 appropriation (\$1.4 million) for proper execution. This is a congressional interest item. The transfer authority is pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-87, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2004; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-136, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2004. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and the Congress has not previously denied any of the items.
