This internal reprogramming action is submitted in two parts: **Part I** transfers \$15.071 million from the Procurement Ammunition, Army, 03/05, appropriation back to the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 03/04. **Part II** transfers \$15.071 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund, 03/04 to the Aircraft Procurement, Army, 03/05, appropriation. These funds were initially transferred from the IFF to Procurement Ammunition, Army, 03/05 via reprogramming action FY 03-25 PA. This transfer is in accordance with provisions of the Emergency Wartime Supplemental Appropriation Act, 2003, Public Law 108-11.

Explanation: This urgent reprogramming action is in support of both Operations Iraqi Freedom and Enduring Freedom. It complies with the Acting Secretary of the Army's guidance to accelerate development and procurement of Aircraft Survivability Equipment. It provides Common Missile Warning System/Improved Countermeasure Dispensing System (CMWS/ICMD) for fixed and rotary wing aircraft currently deployed and ones that will be deployed in the future. The Aircraft Survivability Equipment (ASE) provides our aviators with a capability to detect and counter Infrared Shoulder-Fired Anti-aircraft (MANPAD) Missile Systems.
