This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it exceeds thresholds. This action realigns \$106.1 million within the Other Procurement, Army appropriation to procure additional Force Protection requirements. This action reprograms funds in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than that for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and the Congress has not previously denied any of the items.


Modification of In Service Equipment - Ballistic Protection Armor Kits	286,420	286,420	+106,100	392,520

Explanation: The Army proposes using this \$106,100 to purchase additional Add-on Armor Kits for deployed High Mobility Multi-purpose Wheel Vehicles (HMMWV) and other trucks in support of current operations. These kits have been demonstrated to provide an effective level of force protection against small arms and improvised explosive devices for troops traveling in convoys and on patrol. These funds will enable the Army to procure approximately 3,482 Add on Armor kits.
