Pursuant to the authorities provided by the various Environmental Restoration (ER) transfer appropriations, as enacted by Public Law 108-287, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2005, this action transfers \$1,349.38 million from the five ER appropriations to the Components' Operation and Maintenance appropriations for approved environmental restoration efforts. Under 10 U.S.C. 2703 (b), funds transferred from the various Defense ER transfer appropriations to other Defense appropriations may only be obligated or expended for environmental restoration functions.

Pursuant to the authorities provided in 10 U.S.C. 2703(f), \$1.051 million from an out-of-court settlement administered by the Department of Justice with Intertek Testing Services was previously credited to the FY 2004 ER, Army (\$0.621 million) and FY 2004 ER, Air Force (\$0.430 million) appropriations. This action transfers these credited funds from the ER, Army appropriation and ER, Air Force appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 05/05, appropriation and Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 05/05, appropriation for approved environmental restoration efforts. Funds transferred from the various Defense ER transfer appropriations to other Defense appropriations may be obligated or expended only in accordance with 10 U.S.C. 2703(b).

Explanation: This action transfers \$1,349.38 million appropriated to the Department of Defense for environmental restoration efforts in FY 2005 from the various Defense ER transfer appropriations to the Components' Operation and Maintenance (O&M) appropriations for execution.

This action transfers \$1.051 million from unobligated balances in the ER, Defense appropriation to the O&M appropriations of the Army and Air Force, respectively, for approved environmental restoration efforts.
