This reprogramming action transfers \$160.788 million for the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 04/06, to the Other Procurement, Army, 05/07, and the Research, Development, Test and Evaluation, Army 05/06 appropriations to support critical electronic countermeasures (ECM) equipment to protect convoys and mounted patrols from Improvised Explosives Devices (IEDs).

Explanation: Funds procurement of various electronic countermeasures (ECM) equipment and devices to protect mounted patrols and convoys in Iraq from remote-controlled Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs). The funding requested ensures ECM production to meet urgent theater requirements. Failure to fund ECM exposes convoys and mounted patrols to increased risk from IEDs as they perform their missions. This action satisfies the required new start notification.
