This reprogramming action is submitted in three parts. **Part I** realigns \$12.0 million within Other Procurement, Navy, 05/07, appropriation. **Part II** realigns \$12.762 million within Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 05/06, appropriation. **Part III** transfers \$15.929 million from Other Procurement, Navy, 05/07, appropriation to Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 05/06, appropriation. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2005; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2005, and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements, and the items have not previously been denied by the Congress



Explanation: In the Other Procurement, Navy, 05/07, appropriation, the primary element for the Battle Stations-21 effort is in the development of the Training Management System. Per the DoD Financial Management Regulation, development, test and evaluation requirements, including designing prototypes and processes, should be budgeted as research, development, test, and evaluation. Therefore, this effort for \$15.929 million is more appropriately funded in the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 05/06, appropriation.

The FY 2005 baseline amounts have not yet been adjusted for undistributed congressional reductions.
