Explanation: Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) personnel need a wheeled armored vehicle that provides blast protection, adequate cargo, and workspace to transport EOD equipment and personnel in support of the Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Defeat mission. Funds will procure 88 Cougar armored vehicles. It will also fund facilitization costs to accelerate vehicle production for final delivery to February 2006 from July 2006, pay for training, initial fielding and spares. Funds will also provide for testing to ensure compliance with driving/handling standards. The total Cougar vehicle requirement for this mission is 122 vehicles. The additional \$24.9 million for the remaining 34 vehicles are included in the FY 2005 Supplemental request pending before Congress.
