Explanation: Funds initiate development and testing of a wearable jammer system to support Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Defeat mission. The Small, Light Weight Advanced Modular-Digital Electronic Protection System (SLAM-DEP) incorporates existing jammer technology into a wearable vest to be worn by the warfighter. Funds will provide for the procurement and testing of 50 systems for a platoon size unit and the ability to develop tactics, techniques, and procedures to integrate this product into fighting units. This is a **new start**.
