
Explanation: Funds support a 90-day experimental imaging effort in support of the IED Defeat mission. The effort consists of three contractor-operated OV-1D aircraft with sensors. Mohawk Stare will demonstrate the ability to track movements and collect data in theater on a continuous day and night cycle. This capacity has been tested in the United States and will now be tested in theater. Continuation of the effort depends on the results of the demonstration. This is a **new start**.
