To support the Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Defeat mission, this reprogramming action transfers \$11.388 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund (IFF), 04/06, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 05/05, appropriation (\$7.7 million) and the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 05/06, appropriation (\$3.688 million) for proper execution. This transfer is in accordance with provisions in Title IX of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2005.
