Part I of this reprogramming action transfers \$1.7 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 05/05, appropriation back to the Environmental Restoration, Defense-Wide (ER, D-W) appropriation pursuant to the authority provided by the ER, D-W transfer appropriation, as enacted by Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2005.

Part II of this reprogramming action realigns \$0.4 million of previously transferred ER, D-W resources within the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 05/05, appropriation to carry out environmental restoration activities. Under 10 U.S.C. 2703 (b), funds transferred from ER, D-W transfer appropriation may only be obligated or expended for environmental restoration functions.
