This reprogramming is submitted in two parts. **Part I** transfers \$47.967 million from the Iraq Freedom Fund, 04/06, appropriation to Other Procurement, Army, 05/07, appropriation to support the Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Defeat mission. **Part II** transfers \$2.0 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 05/05, appropriation back to the Iraq Freedom Fund, 04/06, appropriation. These funds were initially transferred to Operation and Maintenance, Army, 05/05, appropriation in FY 05-24 IR. These transfers are in accordance with provisions in Title IX of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2005.


