This reprogramming action is submitted in two parts. **Part I** realigns \$1.7 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 05/06, appropriation. **Part II** transfers \$3.3 million from Procurement, Marine Corps, 05/07, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 05/06, appropriation. **Part II** uses \$3.3 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2005; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2005. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.
