
This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority, pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2005; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2005, and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements, and the items have not been previously denied by the Congress.

Explanation: The funds will provide urgent humanitarian relief in response to the tsunami in South Asia in December 2004. OHDACA requirements are actively being developed; funds will be transferred as needed to meet requirements identified by The Joint Staff and U.S. Pacific Command. Request expedited Congressional approval to allow rapid DoD response to the disaster.
