This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2005; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2005, and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action transfers \$161.3 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 05/05, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test and Evaluation, Air Force, 05/06, appropriation (\$7.7 million); Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 05/07, appropriation (\$139.2 million); and Missile Procurement, Air Force, 05/07, appropriation (\$14.4 million). This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements, and the items have not previously been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: Funds an additional 15 MQ-1 Predator air vehicles in FY 2005, increasing production from 1.5 to 2.0 aircraft per month. The increase in production allows the employment of a seventh orbit 60 days from receipt of funding, an eighth orbit 120 days from receipt of funding, and 12 total orbits by October 2005. Also funds additional communication/support equipment, initial spares, and ground control stations.
