This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval in accordance with Title 10, United States Code, section 127 (a), and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action transfer \$50.0 million from Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 05/05, appropriation and \$125.0 million from Operation and Maintenance, Navy, 05/05, appropriation to the Overseas Humanitarian, Disaster, and Civic Aid, Defense, 05/06, appropriation. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements of the Congress and the Congress has not denied the items.


