



This internal reprogramming is submitted in two parts. **Part I** transfers \$31.917 million from the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 06/07, appropriation (\$1.250 million), the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 06/07, appropriation (\$3.4 million); the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Air Force, 06/07, appropriation (\$21.490 million), the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 06/07, appropriation (\$1.0 million), the Defense Health Program (DHP) Procurement, 06/08, appropriation (\$.882 million), and from the DHP, Operation and Maintenance, 06/06, appropriation, (\$3.895 million) to the DHP, Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, 06/07, appropriation for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-148, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations, Emergency Supplemental Appropriations to Address Hurricanes in the Gulf of Mexico, and Pandemic Influenza Act, 2006; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-163, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2006. **Part II** transfers \$1.0 million from the Other Procurement, Air Force, 05/07, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Air Force, 05/06, appropriation for proper execution. This action uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 108-287, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2005; and section 1001 of Public Law 108-375, the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for 2005. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress

Explanation: In FY 2006, the Congress provided an additional \$1.250 million in Research, Development, Test and Evaluation (RDT&E), Army, appropriation; \$3.4 million in the RDT&E, Navy, appropriation; \$21.490 million in the RDT&E, Air Force, appropriation; \$1.0 million in the RDT&E, Defense-Wide (RDT&E, D-W), appropriation; \$0.882 million in the Defense Health Program (DHP) Procurement budget activity, and \$3.895 million in the DHP Operation and Maintenance budget activity of special interest funding. This reprogramming action transfers these congressional special interest items in the amount of \$31.917 million into the DHP RDT&E budget activity, which is the correct appropriation and budget activity to properly execute funds in accordance with congressional intent.

To comply with congressional intent, the funds need to be transferred to Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Air Force, 05/06, appropriation because the initiative is budgeted in Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation (RDT&E) and the task continuation was approved in RDT&E for \$1.4 million in the FY 2006 DoD Appropriation Act.
