

This reprogramming action support the Improvised Explosive Device (IED) defeat mission by transferring \$1,558.089 million from the Joint Improvised Explosive Device Defeat Fund, (JIEDDF) 06/08, appropriation to the Other Procurement, Army, 06/08; Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 06/07; and Operation and Maintenance, Army, 06/06 appropriations. This transfer is in accordance with Public Law 109-234, Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror, and Hurricane Recovery, 2006. This action supports an urgent, real-time, warfighting need and meets all administrative and legal requirements and the items have not previously been denied by the Congress.
