This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval under the authority of the Joint Resolution Making Continuing Appropriations for the Fiscal Year 2006 and section 8005 of the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2005. This action transfers \$60.0 million to the Overseas Humanitarian, Disaster, and Civic Aid, Defense, 06/07, appropriation to enable continued relief operations to the victims of the Pakistan earthquake. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.
