This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-148, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations, Emergency Supplemental Appropriations to Address Hurricanes in the Gulf of Mexico, and Pandemic Influenza Act, 2006; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-163, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2006. This reprogramming action transfers \$90.7 million among various Defense appropriations to support the Defense Security Services Personnel Security Investigations Program. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.


