

Explanation: These funds are being made available to the Department of the Army to provide communication infrastructure support to New Camp Kabul and Camp Phoenix compounds, which are being constructed to reduce current force protection vulnerabilities resulting from personnel being billeted in "safe" houses off of compounds. Specifically, funding will provide communications routers, switches, cabling and other infrastructure support associated with relocation within Afghanistan of the Combined Security Transition Command to the New Kabul and Camp Phoenix compounds.
