This reprogramming action transfers \$243.5 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 06/07, appropriation to various National Guard appropriations. This transfer is in accordance with Public Law 109-234, Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror, and Hurricane Recovery, 2006, Title V. These funds will support the continued deployment of up to 6,000 National Guard members to the southern border of the United States. As directed by the President, these personnel will assist the Department of Homeland Security's Border Patrol by operating surveillance systems, building infrastructure, analyzing intelligence, and providing training until new Border Patrol agents and technologies come on line. These funds will finance the pay, allowances, operational cost, and procurement of support equipment for the National Guard's Border Security operations during the remainder of FY 2007.


