This action realigns \$16.2 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 06/07, appropriation. This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items has previously been denied by the Congress. This reprogramming action also satisfies the notification requirements of section 504 of the National Security Act of 1947 (50 USC 414).


