

Explanation: These funds are being moved for the purpose of proper execution and this action does not change the purpose or intent for which these funds were appropriated. This transfer is critical to executing one of the Secretary of Defense’s Top 25 Transformation Priorities. Without altering the distinct lines of authority for establishing policies and procedures relating to security clearance, Federal employment suitability, and related determinations, such reform should ensure that the executive branch executes these authorities within a framework that maximizes efficiency and effectiveness while protecting the information collected from unauthorized use or disclosure. Embedding that framework in policies, practices, and infrastructure will ensure that the reform effort and its benefits will continue into the future. To accomplish this priority, PDM2 realigned program management and funding for the Defense Information System for Security (DISS) from DSS to BTA in FY 2009, and also directed the action for FY 2008. This action accomplishes that transfer for FY 2008.
