This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Public Law 109-289, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2007; and section 1001 of Public Law 109-364, the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2007. This action transfers \$35.2 million from Other Procurement, Army, 07/09, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 07/08, appropriation to finance the Medium Extended Air Defense System (MEADS) program. This action reprograms funding in support of higher-priority items than those for which originally appropriated, and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

Explanation: Medium Extended Air Defense System (MEADS) is a tri-national co-development program among the United States, Germany and Italy to replace the U.S. Patriot air defense systems, PATRIOT and HAWK systems in Germany, and NIKE Hercules systems in Italy. Funding is for critical items associated with the U.S. equipment contribution needed to meet the US commitment to the Tri-National MEADS program. These items are the Exciter, Electronic Support Measures, Exportable Missile Model, US Model and Simulation Development and Activities, Identification Friend or Foe, US Certification, Software Assessment and IT Security, and the Missile Segment Enhancement (MSE) integration into ground equipment. The Exciter is on the international program's critical path for development of the Multifunction Fire Control Radar while the other items are government furnished direct enablers for the Tri-National Programs.
