This reprogramming action transfers \$951.0 million from the Mine Resistant Ambush Protected (MRAP) Vehicle Transfer Fund, 09/10, appropriation to various Defense Appropriations for execution in FY 2009. This is pursuant to the authority provided by Public Law 111-32, the Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2009. It supports urgent warfighting needs for the protection of operating forces in Iraq and Afghanistan.

This reprogramming action transfers \$951.0 million from the MRAP Vehicle Transfer Fund to Army, Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps and US Special Operations Command (USSOCOM) to procure MATV vehicles, government furnished equipment, initial logistics support, and transport vehicles to Afghanistan.
