Description: This project constructs a ground water treatment plan capable of treating arsenic and fluoride. The project consists of a water supply/treatment building, a plant utilities building, a potable water storage tank, distribution lines, and building information systems.

Justification: This FY 2008 project was authorized and appropriated at \$11.8 million. Subsequently, Congress rescinded \$3.5 million when notified that the project was awarded for \$8.3 million. During execution, the Nevada Department of Environmental Protection mandated within scope electrical and mechanical changes affecting the treatment process. Compliance is required in order for the Ground Water Treatment Plant to be licensed and certified for operation. This project is currently one percent complete and the contractor has adjusted the work schedule to complete all work not affected by this mandatory change. A contract modification must be funded prior to June 2009 to preclude contractor demobilization.
