This reprogramming action transfers \$131.268 million from the five Environmental Restoration (ER) transfer appropriations to the Components' Operation and Maintenance (O&M) appropriations for approved environmental restoration activities for proper execution pursuant to section 101 of Public Law 111-68, Continuing Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2010.

Pursuant to authorities provided under 10 U.S.C. 2703(e), \$5.434 million was credited to the Environmental Restoration, Army transfer appropriation as a result of a court settlement action with Textron administered by the Department of Justice. This reprogramming action also transfers these credited funds to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 10/10, appropriation for approved environmental restoration activities.

Under 10 U.S.C. 2703(c), funds transferred from the various Defense ER transfer appropriations to other Defense appropriations may only be obligated or expended for environmental restoration functions.
