This reprogramming action transfers \$442.0 million from the Mine Resistant Ambush Protected (MRAP) Transfer Fund, 09/10, appropriation to various Defense Appropriations for execution in FY 2010. This is pursuant to the authority provided by Public Law 111-32, the Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2009. It supports urgent warfighting needs for the protection of operating forces in Iraq and Afghanistan. This reprogramming action transfers funds for the procurement of government furnished equipment (GFE), vehicle upgrades, and initial logistics support and for ballistic and integration testing of vehicles and retrofit upgrades.
