Silver Fox is an Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) that includes both aircraft and a ground station. This small UAS can be used as the host platform for a variety of payloads for multiple missions including force protection, intelligence collection, surveillance, reconnaissance (ISR), and target acquisition. The RDT&E funding shall cover the cost of payload integration of an Army-developed Measurements and Signature Intelligence (MASINT) and Electro-Optical Infrared into the latest model C-3 Silver Fox Unmanned Aerial Vehicle. This is a congressional special interest item.
