These reprogramming actions are submitted for prior approval because these actions exceed established reprogramming thresholds. These actions reprogram funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

Budget Activity 5: Modification of Aircraft				-	
AH-1W Series	6,356		6,305	+19,300	25,605

Explanation: Funding is required for AH-1W Critical Cockpit Upgrade (CCU) capability that provides a moving map, Blue Force Situational Awareness and Variable Message Format (Digital Messaging) capabilities for the AH-1W. These capabilities are required to significantly decrease the time to execute Close Air Support and Forward Air Control (Airborne) missions, and ensure greater awareness of friendly unit positions, mitigating the potential for fratricide.

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Explanation: Funding is available because the FY 2010 aircraft supported by the FY 2009 advance procurement funding were not requested or appropriated in the FY 2010 budget.

Budget Activity 4: Other Aircraft

KC-130J	9	773,282	9	711,847	+19,300	9	791,147
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Explanation: The KC-130J aircraft, an all weather plane utilized for cargo and personnel transport and in-flight refueling, has been actively deployed in support of OIF/OEF/OCO since February 2005. The FY 2008 Supplemental Appropriation Act directed the Marine Corps to procure nine KC-130J aircraft. However, insufficient funding was appropriated to procure the ninth aircraft based on the negotiated contract. This reprogramming provides the additional funding for procurement of all nine aircraft as directed by Congress.

Budget Activity 5: Modification of Aircraft

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Explanation: Funding is available due to a longer than anticipated time to implement a viable, cost effective solution and can be reprogrammed with minimal risk. The FY 2009 portion of this reprogramming action returns funding to the Critical Cockpit Upgrade (CCU) effort.
